SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 76241, dated September 30, 1969, granted applicant a Class "B" charter-party certificate from a service area extending 25 miles from applicant's terminal at Adelanto, California. On January 9, 1970, applicant filed a petition to modify Decision No. 76241, by extending the pickup area to 34 miles, with the restriction included that the extension not include any area which is not within the First Supervisorial District of San Bernardino County. A protest to the requested extension was filed by Greyhound Lines - West, on February 2, 1970. Greyhound Lines - West advised the protest would be withdrawn if Barstow was excluded from the 34-mile authority requested. Applicant filed a letter on February 26, 1970, wherein it was agreed that Barstow could be removed from the new authority.

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 76241 is hereby modified to read as follows:

"1. A certificate of public convenience and necessity is granted to Drahos Transportation, Inc., authorizing it to operate as a Class "B" charter-party carrier of passengers, as defined in Section 3583 of the Public Utilities Code, from a service area

encompassing a radius of 34 air miles from applicant's terminal at Adelanto, California. This certificate is subject to the restriction that the service area granted does not include any area inside the city limits of Barstow, nor any area which is not located within the presently existing geographic boundaries of the First Supervisorial District of San Bernardino County."

In all other respects Decision No. 76241 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be ten days after the date hereof.
