FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Pursuant to authority granted by Decision No. 76690, dated January 20, 1970, in the above-entitled matter, Dominguez Water Corporation issued a \$500,000 note and a \$400,000 note, both notes being in favor of Bank of America National Trust and Savings Association and bearing a due date of March 31, 1970. The company requests a modification of said authority so as to enable it to continue the bank borrowings until April 30, 1970.

After consideration the Commission finds that the requested modification is reasonable. On the basis of this finding we conclude that the petition should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that Ordering Paragraph No. 1 of Decision No. 76690, dated January 20, 1970, is hereby amended to read as follows:

1. Dominguez Water Corporation, for the purposes set forth in this proceeding, may issue and reissue notes in the aggregate principal amount of not exceeding \$900,000, and may enter into agreements extending the due dates thereof, provided that the interest rate shall not exceed that determined in the manner described in this proceeding and the due dates shall be no later than April 30, 1970.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
