O R D E R

County of Shasta is hereby authorized to construct a road at grade across a track of Southern Pacific Transportation Company near the City of Redding, Shasta County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. CP-266.2.

Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than as shown on the plan attached to the application. The proposed roadway is in a cut section which will impair vehicular sight distances along the track. As part of the construction applicant shall remove the embankment to provide a sight distance of 200 feet along the track for motorists 50 feet in advance of the crossing. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Applicant shall bear entire expense of construction, also maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Transportation Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
