O R D E R

The County of Riverside is hereby authorized to construct a new crossing at grade across a track of the Southern Pacific Transportation Company near Corona, Riverside County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. BJ-558.2.

Width of crossing shall be not less than 50 feet and grades of approach as indicated in application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Applicant shall bear entire expense of construction and installation of protection, also maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Southern Pacific Transportation Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines.

All trees located within and adjacent to the railroad right-of-way within 200 feet of the centerline of the proposed

crossing shall be removed at the sole expense of applicant.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
