S U P P L E M E N T A L O R D E R

Southern Pacific Transportation Company, having on November 11 and December 16, 1969, requested that the Commission modify requirements Nos. 1 and 25 in Decision No. 71908, dated January 24, 1967, governing operations on its Los Angeles Division, the interested operating railroad brotherhoods being in accord that such modifications are necessary and desirable, investigation by the staff of the Transportation Division having determined that operations can be conducted safely under the terms of said modifications, and it appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that Southern Pacific Transportation Company's request should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that requirement Nos. 1 and 25, in Decision No. 71908, dated January 24, 1967, governing operations on Southern Pacific Transportation Company's Los Angeles Division, are hereby amended to read:

1. Callexico Branch. Niland to Callexico - 41 miles. Movements shall be governed by centralized traffic control signal indications between Niland and Calipatria, in accordance with Rule 93 from Calipatria to Milepost 705 supplemented by automatic block signal protection between Calipatria and El Centro, and shall be restricted to one movement at a time between Milepost 705 and Callexico by the use of a train register located at El Centro.

25. Torrance Branch. South Los Angeles to Harbor City - 12.1 miles. Movements shall be made in accordance with Rule 93. Movements between South Los Angeles and Dolanco shall be programmed to avoid conflict.

In all other respects Decision No. 71908, dated January 24, 1967, as amended by Decision No. 73658, dated January 30, 1968 and by Decision No. 75136, dated December 20, 1968, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall be effective on the date hereof.
