ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR PAYMENT OF FINE

Commission Decision No. 74068, issued herein May 7, 1968, ordered the respondent to pay a fine of \$9,315.53 on or before July 10, 1968. The period within which to pay the fine had been extended to January 1, 1970.

Respondent is now insolvent, has no assets and has not operated since September of 1968. It has a court action pending and the State of California is withholding money owing until the court determines who should be paid. Respondent requests another extension to provide time for the court to issue a decision and the money to be paid.

IT IS ORDERED that the time within which respondent Zebra Trucking is ordered to pay the sum of \$9,315.53 pursuant to paragraph 1 of the order in Decision No. 74068, dated May 7, 1968, in Case No. 8733, is extended to September 15, 1970.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
