FINAL ORDER

Decision No. 75939, dated July 29, 1969, in this proceeding granted Greyhound Lines, Inc. (Greyhound) an interim increase in fares and express rates and indicated that further hearings should be scheduled for the receipt of additional evidence concerning the so-called "affiliated interests" adjustments proposed by the Commission staff, and concerning a reasonable rate of return applicable to final rates.

By letter dated January 7, 1970, the Secretary of the Commission advised Greyhound that the record herein may be considered to be stale unless action to conclude the proceeding is taken forthwith. Said letter stated that if this proceeding is discontinued, the question of "affiliated interests" adjustments will be considered in a future fare proceeding based on a current record.

By letter dated March 17, 1970, Greyhound's counsel advised the Commission's Secretary as follows:

"We have given further consideration to your letter of January 7, 1970, concerning the referenced proceeding and hereby respectfully request that such proceeding be discontinued and an order be entered making the interim relief granted July 22, 1969, in Decision No. 75939, final."

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 75959 is the final order of the Commission herein. No further proceeding will be had in Application No. 50792 and the matter is hereby closed.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
