In the Matter of the Application of NIPOMO COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT, a political subdivision of the State of California, to obtain the permission of the Public Utilities Commission to the transfer of the Savage Water Company, a California corporation.

OPINION

Nipomo Community Services District requests authority to acquire the water supply and distribution system of the Savage Water Company.

Nipomo Community Services District is a community service district organized and existing pursuant to the laws of the State of California and is located entirely within the County of San Luis Obispo. On December 23, 1968, Nipomo Community Services District acquired all of the real and personal property of the Savage Water Company pursuant to a judgment in condemnation issued by the Superior Court of the State of California in and for the County of San Luis Obispo.

After consideration, the Commission finds that the proposed transfer would not be adverse to the public interest and, upon consummation of the transfer, that public convenience and necessity would no longer require the service of Savage Water Company within the area herein considered. A public hearing is not necessary.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. On or before July 1, 1970, Savage Water Company may transfer to the Nipomo Community Services District the water system herein referred to.
- 2. On or before the date of actual transfer, Savage Water Company shall return to customers any refundable deposits made to establish credit.
- 3. Upon the compliance with the conditions of this order, Savage Water Company shall stand relieved of its public utility obligations, and may discontinue service concurrently with the commencement of service by Nipomo Community Services District.
- 4. The Secretary is directed to mail certified copies of this order to Mr. Robert M. Simpson, President, Savage Water Company, P.O. Box 84, Station A, Berkeley, California, 94712, and to Mr. Robert M. Simpson, President, Savage Water Company, 931 Hearst Avenue, Berkeley, California, or to his last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
