O P I N I O N

Greyhound Lines, Inc. requests authority to sell property in Oakland to the State of California, Department of Public Works, Division of Highways.

It is alleged that the property, which is to be acquired by the State for freeway construction, has heretofore been used by applicant as a bus parking and service facility; the sale of said property, valued at \$210,000, is to be consummated not later than May 1, 1970; subsequent thereto applicant will remain in possession pursuant to a month-to-month lease at a monthly rental of \$420; and applicant will eventually acquire, or arrange, for the use of suitable property for bus parking to replace the facilities to be sold.

After consideration the Commission finds that the proposed transfer would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. On or before May 1, 1970, Greyhound Lines, Inc. may sell and transfer to the State of California, Department of Public Works, Division of Highways, the property described in the application.

2. Within ten days after the consummation of the transfer herein authorized, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing and shall file with the Commission a copy of the bill of sale or of any such instrument executed to effect said transfer.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
