ORDER GRANTING REHEARING

A petition for modification, rehearing and suspension of Decision No. 76662, filed January 23, 1970, and a subsequent pleading filed March 9, 1970, abandoning that portion of its petition which requests rehearing, having been filed by Leisure World Foundation, protestant herein, and the Commission having considered each and every allegation thereof and being of the opinion that the public interest will be best served by holding a limited rehearing as hereinafter set forth,

IT IS ORDERED that rehearing of Decision No. 76662 will be held. The rates ordered in Decision No. 76662 shall remain in effect pending further order of the Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said rehearing shall be limited to the subject of construction water sales and revenue and related expense items, and the effect such matters may have, if any, on the rates fixed in Decision No. 76662.

The Secretary is directed to cause the appropriate notice of hearing to be mailed at least ten (10) days before such rehearing.
