OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 77075, entered today in this proceeding, rules relating to minimum charges for transportation in vacuum-type and pump-type vehicles when performed on holidays are established. The decision found that in order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution Minimum Rate Tariff No. 13 should be amended by separate order; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 13 (Appendix B to Decision No. 55584, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective May 23, 1970, Seventh Revised Page 7 and Original Page 7-A attached hereto, which pages by this reference are made a part hereof.
- 2. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject also to Decision No. 55584, as amended, be and they are hereby directed to establish in their tariffs the increases necessary to conform with the further adjustments ordered herein.

- 3. Tariff publications resulting in increases required or authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order, on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public; such tariff publications as are required shall be made effective not later than May 23, 1970.
- 4. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rates authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rates published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.
- 5. In all other respects said Decision No. 55584, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shell be twenty-four days after the date hereof.
