SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 76766, dated February 10, 1970 in the above-entitled matter, ordered respondent Edward A. Daugh to pay a fine in the amount of \$250.

On April 2, 1970 a check in the amount of \$100 was received from Edward A. Daugh in partial payment of the fine together with a request that he be granted a 30 day extension of the time to pay the \$150 due.

The Commission having considered such request and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Edward A. Daugh shall pay the \$150 balance of the fine imposed by Decision No. 76766 on or before May 4, 1970.
2. In all other respects Decision No. 76766 shall remain in full force and effect.
