ORDER MODIFYING DECISION

Certain changes authorized in the gas tariff schedules of Pacific Gas and Electric Company were not correctly translated into the Appendix of Decision No. 77102. Said Appendix should be revised in order to correct errors.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Minimum Charge for Schedule No. G-45, Gas Engine Agricultural Natural Gas Service, shown on Page 4 of the Appendix is cancelled and replaced by the following.

Per Meter Per Month

Minimum Charge:

May to October, inclusive	\$5.00
November to April, inclusive	1.00
Minimum charges for twelve months' continuous service are accumulative at the rate of \$36.00 per meter per year.	

2. The offset charges listed under related FPC Dockets RP69-6 and RP69-20 Tracking through 9-17-69 in the tabulation on Page 2 of the Appendix are cancelled and replaced by offset charges of .148 cents per therm and .045 cents per therm, respectively.

The effective date of the revised rates shall be April 16, 1970 or one day after the date of filing, whichever is later. These are the dates on which the rates according to the Appendix as originally issued became effective.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
