ORDER OF MODIFICATION

Written request has been made on behalf of respondent Donald R. Stanfield for relief from the requirement of ordering paragraph 5 of Decision No. 68295 as modified by Decision No. 70127 which requires the filing of a report on the first Monday of every third month on the status of efforts to collect undercharges. Respondent was awarded judgment against G. N. Dodge in the amount of \$10,140.65 plus interest, but because defendant has gone out of business and because respondent has been unable to locate assets of defendant with which to satisfy judgment, respondent requests that he be relieved of the requirement to file reports until such time as the judgment can be satisfied.

IT IS ORDERED that Donald R. Stanfield is relieved from the requirement of filing reports in compliance with paragraph 5 of Decision No. 68295 as amended by Decision No. 70127 until such time as the judgment against G. N. Dodge can be satisfied. In the event the judgment is satisfied, Donald R. Stanfield shall file a report within ten days setting forth the results thereof.

In all other respects Decision No. 68295 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
