ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Public hearings were held on the above-entitled matter before Examiner Coffey on March 10 and 25, 1970. At the conclusion of the hearing on March 25, 1970, all parties agreed that further consideration of issues in the above-entitled matter should be pursued in a subsequent newly instituted investigation. It was further agreed that Hornitos Telephone Company would request permanent suspension of its Advice Letter No. 19 to permit termination of the said proceeding. By letter dated April 10, 1970 Hornitos Telephone Company requested permanent suspension of its Advice Letter No. 19.
