ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

The certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to John E. Duckett, doing business as White's Truck Service (Duckett), was suspended on May 27, 1968, for failure to maintain tariffs in effect. The certificate was continued in suspension until October 10, 1969, at the request of Duckett, to allow him time to reorganize his business. The required tariffs were not filed to become effective with the termination date of the suspension period and Duckett's participation in National Motor Freight Classification A-10 was canceled on March 13, 1970. To date the carrier has not filed the required tariffs and classification.

John E. Duckett having failed to have on file the required tariffs and classification, the Commission finds such failures constitute good cause for revocation of the certificate.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier granted to John E. Duckett by Decision No. 54517 dated February 11, 1957, in Application No. 36224 is hereby revoked.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon John E. Duckett or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof.
