Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D at "F" Street Underpass (Crossing No. 36B-7.52-B).

The construction of the new grade crossings and the alteration of the existing grade crossings herein authorized shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72.

Maintenance cost of the crossings outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. The San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossings between such lines. The new crossings and widened portions of the altered crossings shall not be opened to public use until after the protection ordered herein is installed and operative. No obstructions shall be placed near the flashing light signals which will impair the motorists' view.

An agreement has been entered into between the parties relative to construction expense. However, the parties are not in agreement as to apportionment of maintenance expense of the automatic protection to be installed. The Commission finds that it will not apportion the cost of construction of the crossing protection inasmuch as said apportionment is the subject of federal regulations and beyond our jurisdiction. The Commission will apportion the cost of maintenance of the automatic protection by further order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
