ORDER RESCINDING ORDER OF REVOCATION

Decision No. 77142 dated April 28, 1970, provided for revocation of the operative rights and cancellation of the tariffs of certain public utility warehousemen that are engaged exclusively in the storage of baled cotton. Through inadvertence, the operative right of West Coast Warehouse Corporation was revoked when only its tariff naming rates for the storage of cotton should have been canceled.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the necessary correction should be made by the order herein. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the order of revocation should be rescinded insofar as it concerns the operative right of West Coast Warehouse Corporation and the involved tariff should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Decision No. 77142 dated April 28, 1970, is hereby rescinded insofar as the operative right of West Coast Warehouse Corporation is concerned.

2. West Coast Warehouse Corporation Warehouse Tariff No. 1, Cal.P.U.C. No. 1, is hereby canceled.

3. In all other respects, Decision No. 77142 shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective May 28, 1970.
