FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Pursuant to authority granted by Ordering Paragraph No. 2  
 of Decision No. 76601, dated December 23, 1969, in the above-entitled  
 matter, Pollock Water Service, Inc. and Village Water Company merged

into California-American Water Company. Ordering Paragraph No. 9 of said decision reads as follows:

"After consummation of the mergers, California-American Water Company shall maintain its records in such form as to provide a segregation of accounts relating to the plant investment and pertinent rate base items, as well as the revenues and expenses, for the areas represented by Pollock Water Service, Inc. and Village Water Company."

The Commission's Finance and Accounts Division has expressed the opinion that the integrated operations resulting from the mergers preclude the necessity for continuing to maintain records in accordance with said Ordering Paragraph No. 9, and we so find.

On the basis of the foregoing finding we conclude that said Ordering Paragraph No. 9 should be rescinded. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that Ordering Paragraph No. 9 of Decision No. 76601, dated December 23, 1969, is hereby rescinded.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 76601 shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this order.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
