ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 76672 dated January 13, 1970, Richard L. Cain and Mary E. Cain were authorized to conduct passenger stage service for the transportation of passengers, their baggage and shipments of express between Bishop, the Mammoth Lakes area, the June Lake area and intermediate points. Because of the current Teamsters' strike applicants have not received delivery of four Club Wagon buses and as a result have been unable to commence service.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the time within which to commence operations pursuant to the provisions of Decision No. 76672 is hereby extended to July 15, 1970.
