This is a complaint by John R. Camm and others against J. J. Downey, doing business as Inverness Park Water Company. John R. Camm, the principal complainant, has filed a written request asking that the complaint be dismissed because the North Marin County Water District has formed an improvement district for the express purpose of taking over the defendant water company and providing improvements to the water system. A letter from the North Marin County Water District, which has been made part of the record, corroborates these facts. In the circumstances, the Commission is of the opinion that the complaint should be dismissed without prejudice.

IT IS ORDERED that the complaint in Case No. 9020 is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
