OPINION

Peerless Stages, Incorporated requests an order of the Commission authorizing it to sell and transfer to the Department of Public Works of the State of California real property on which the company's Oakland offices, shop and bus parking facilities are located.

Said real property is described as follows:

PARCEL NO. 1 (Oakland Office Property)

All that real property in the City of Oakland, County of Alameda, State of California, described as: COMMENCING at the southwesterly corner of that parcel of land described in the deed recorded August 9, 1962, in Recl 651, Image 180 of Official Records of Alameda County; thence along the southerly line of said parcel, N.78°59'06"E., 99.63 feet to the westerly line of San Pablo Avenue; thence along last said line S.13°15'34"E., 8.50 feet; thence S.70°55'11"W., 61.39 feet; thence along a tangent curve to the left with a radius of 164.00 feet, through an angle of 31°15'50", an arc length of 80.49 feet to the southeasterly line of Castro Street; thence along last said line N.27°24'36"E., 67.18 feet to the point of commencement.

After consideration the Commission finds that the sale and transfer of real property as proposed in this proceeding would not be adverse to the public interest. On the basis of this finding we conclude that the application should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

The authorization herein granted shall not be construed as a finding of the value of the property authorized to be sold and transferred.

<u>O R D E R</u>

IT IS ORDERED that Peerless Stages, Incorporated may sell and transfer to the Department of Public Works of the State of California the real property described in this proceeding, the price to be not less than \$205,313.
