ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

The certificate of public convenience and necessity acquired by East Bay Parcel Delivery, a corporation, has been suspended since October 1, 1969, for failure, on the part of the carrier, to maintain its tariff on file in conformity with the Commission's outstanding minimum rate orders. The necessary tariff amendments have not been filed to date.

East Bay Parcel Delivery having failed to maintain its tariff on file in conformity with the Commission's outstanding minimum rate orders, the Commission finds that such failure constitutes good cause for revocation of the carrier's certificate and cancellation of the tariff applicable to the services thereunder.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier acquired by East Bay Parcel Delivery, a corporation, by Decision No. 68484 dated January 19, 1965, as amended by Decision No. 74082, dated May 7, 1968, in Application No. 47188 is hereby revoked.

2. East Bay Parcel Delivery Local Freight Tariff No. 1, Cal.P.U.C. No. 1 (Series of Stanley B. Greig, dba East Bay Parcel Delivery), is hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon East Bay Parcel Delivery or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof.
