SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 77175 dated May 5, 1970, in these proceedings revised certain classification provisions in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 and Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1. Through inadvertence incorrect item number references to National Motor Freight Classification A-11 were published in connection with certain commodity descriptions in the above tariffs.¹

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the necessary corrections should be made by the order herein. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that Decision No. 77175, supra, should be amended accordingly.

The commodity descriptions pertain to "liquid anti-freeze compound" as set forth in Item 723 of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 and "fibreboard, paper, paperboard or pulpboard boxes" as named in Item 1820 of Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 (Appendix D to Decision No. 31606, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective June 11, 1970, Ninth Revised Page 51-F attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 (Appendix A to Decision No. 66195, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective June 11, 1970, First Revised Page 27-WWW attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

3. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject also to Decisions Nos. 31606 and 66195, as amended, are hereby directed to establish in their tariffs the provisions necessary to conform with the further adjustments ordered herein.

4. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be made effective June 11, 1970, on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and to the public and tariff publications which are authorized but not required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than June 11, 1970 and may be made effective on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than August 10, 1970.

5. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the provisions authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now

maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the provisions published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

6. In all other respects Decisions Nos. 31606 and 66195 as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be June 4, 1970.
