In the Matter of the Investigation on the Commission's own motion into the reasonableness of Water Main Extension Rules presently effective for water utilities throughout the State, and the development of such revised extension rule as appears reasonable.

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 75205, dated January 21, 1969, this Commission prescribed a revised uniform main extension rule to be filed by all water utilities except those which supply water primarily for irrigation uses. Each utility affected was ordered to file the revised rule by May 11, 1969.

Based upon a review of the records in these proceedings, the Commission finds that:

1. Certain utilities are delinquent in complying with ordering paragraph 2 of Decision No. 75205.
2. It is in the public interest that the revised main extension rule prescribed by that decision be placed in effect for each delinquent utility as soon as is practicable.

The Commission concludes that the Commission's Secretary should be empowered to effect the filing of the prescribed main extension rule for each delinquent utility.

IT IS ORDERED that the Secretary of this Commission is authorized and directed (a) to cancel the filed water main extension

rule of any utility which has not complied with Decision No. 75205, and (b) to file in the tariffs of each such utility, the main extension rule prescribed by that decision.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
