ORDER GRANTING DISMISSAL

This joint application was filed by Pacific Southwest Air-
 lines (PSA) and Air California for approval of the acquisition of
 substantially all the assets and liabilities of Air California by PSA
 in exchange for PSA stock.

After eleven days of hearing and the introduction of 52
 exhibits, PSA served notice on May 20, 1970 that it has withdrawn
 from the agreement of acquisition. As a consequence, both PSA and
 Air California request that their joint application be dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that the application is dismissed without
 prejudice.
