IT IS ORDERED that:

1. George Bassi, doing business as Bassi Transportation Service may pay the balance due and owing on the fine of \$7,654.23 imposed on said respondent by ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 76807, dated February 17, 1970, in successive installments of not less than \$300.00 each with the first installment due on July 15, 1970, and each succeeding installment due on the fifteenth day of each month thereafter until said balance has been paid in full.

2. In all other respects, said Decision No. 76807 shall remain in full force and effect.
