Investigation into the status, safety, maintenance, use and protection or closing of various crossings at grade of the lines of Southern Pacific Company, The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, Union Pacific Railroad Company and Pacific Electric Railway Company in the County of San Bernardino, California, with various streets, roads and highways, in said county.

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 72106, dated March 7, 1967, ordered the City of Upland, the City of Ontario, the County of San Bernardino and The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company to share in the costs of installing automatic signal protection at the Grove Avenue Crossing No. 2-99.7.

The City of Upland has requested that it be relieved of the obligation to pay part of the costs of crossing signals at Grove Avenue Crossing No. 2-99.7 of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company as ordered in Paragraph No. 5 in Decision No. 72106.

The County of San Bernardino has advised the Commission that it is willing to assume total local agency costs and has no objections to relieving the Cities of Upland and Ontario from participating in the costs of the automatic crossing protection.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 72106 is amended by relieving the Cities of Upland and Ontario of any obligation to share in the costs of the Grove Avenue Crossing No. 2-99.7.

In all other respects, Decision No. 72106, shall remain in full force and effect.
