Investigation on the Commission's own motion into the safety, maintenance, operation, use and protection of all public grade crossings over the Southern Pacific Company's El Paso Line between Los Angeles and Ontario, the Union Pacific Railroad Company's main line between Los Angeles and Ontario, and The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company's main line between Los Angeles and Upland and between Los Angeles and La Mirada.

SEVENTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 67887 issued on September 22, 1964 ordered the Southern Pacific Transportation Company and other respondents to install automatic signal protection at a number of grade crossings described in Appendix A attached thereto. One such crossing described on page 2 of 2 of Appendix A is the Nogales Avenue Crossing (No. B-504.8) of the Southern Pacific Transportation Company's El Paso main line. Automatic gates were the ordered protection with the public agency's share of the costs to be apportioned equally between the City of Industry and the County of Los Angeles.

The County of Los Angeles requested the Commission by letter to modify the above decision by deleting the County of Los Angeles as a party to share in the cost of the installation of

automatic gates and substitute the City of West Covina as a party assuming the county's share. This request was made because the county's portion of the crossing was annexed to the City of West Covina prior to the installation of the automatic gates.

The City Council of West Covina has agreed to assume the County of Los Angeles' obligation pursuant to the Commission's decision ordering installation of automatic gates at Nogales Avenue.

IT IS ORDERED that page 2 of 2 of Appendix A to Decision No. 67327 where it now reads: "Crossing No. and Street Name, B-504.8, Nogales Avenue; Public Agency Involved, Industry & L.A.Co." is changed to read: "Crossing No. and Street Name, B-504.8, Nogales Avenue; Public Agency Involved, Industry & West Covina".

In all other respects Decision No. 67327, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
