ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Applicant has requested an extension of time within which to exercise the authority granted in Decision No. 76044, alleging that Southern Pacific Transportation Company has indicated the possible abandonment of the crossing at Rose Drive. Should this occur, the crossing protection authorized in the above decision will not be needed.

For this reason, applicant requests that the temporary authority granted in paragraph No. 3 of Decision No. 76044 which reads:

"3. The County of Orange is also authorized to temporarily protect the widened crossing of Rose Drive, Crossing No. 6C-28.50, with two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflecting sheet material, for a period of not to exceed 180 days from the date hereof."

be extended for a period of not to exceed 180 days.

IT IS ORDERED that the time limit within which applicant may temporarily protect the crossing of Rose Drive with two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflecting sheet material is hereby extended to September 9, 1970.

In all other respects, Decision No. 76044 shall remain in full force and effect.
