Southern Pacific Transportation Company is hereby authorized to construct an additional spur track at grade across Thirty-third Avenue in the City of Oakland, Alameda County, at the location described in the application. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.


It is alleged that Thirty-third Avenue is not at present open to public use and travel, and this order is not to be deemed authority for such opening.


Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
