O R D E R

Southern Pacific Transportation Company is hereby authorized to construct a drill track at grade across American Avenue and Alpine Way in the City of Hayward, Alameda County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossings Nos. L-20.63-C and L-20.66-C, respectively. Construction of each crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the roadways now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach at each crossing not exceeding two percent. Protection at the American Avenue Crossing No. L-20.63-C shall be by two Standard No. 3 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented with additional flashing light signals on cantilever arms. Protection at the Alpine Way Crossing No. L-20.66-C shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless

time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
