O R D E R

City of Redondo Beach, on behalf of the City of Hermosa Beach, is hereby authorized to construct Herondo Street at Valley Drive at grade across a track of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company in the Cities of Redondo Beach and Hermosa Beach, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 2W-19.7.

Width of crossing shall be not less than 84 feet and grades of approach not greater than six percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Construction expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines.

Upon completion, the existing Valley Drive, formerly Francisco Avenue, (Crossing No. 2W-19.6) which is adjacent to the above-proposed crossing shall be identified as part of Crossing No. 2W-19.7 and Crossing No. 2W-19.6 shall be removed from the Commission records.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
