## OPINION AND ORDER

By this epplication, J. D. Sherson, Tariff Publishing Officer for the Uniform Classification Committee, seeks authority to publish, on behalf of California railroads, certain changes in furniture packaging requirements named in Uniform Freight Classification No. 9.

Applicant states that revision of the involved package descriptions is necessary to upgrade the specifications in order to alleviate the numerous damage claims which have plagued the rail carriers for many years. The application shows that a hearing on the proposals, attended by furniture manufacturers representatives throughout the country, was held in Chicago on March 19, 1968. The application further shows that the proposed revisions have become effective on interstate traffic and on intrastate traffic in the other 49 states.

The application shows that a large number of shipper organizations and other parties were furnished a copy of the application. The application was listed on the Commission's Calendar of April 1, 1970. No protests have been received.

The Commission finds that any increases resulting from the proposed revised packaging rules are justified. We conclude that the application should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.
