## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 77443 in these proceedings authorized increases in the vehicle unit rates in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 15, to become effective September 1, 1970. Ordering paragraph 3 of said decision authorized common carriers to establish the increased rates on or after August 3, 1970.

California Trucking Association, in its Petition for Modification of Decision No. 77443, filed July 2, 1970, requests modification of ordering paragraph 3 thereof in order that common carriers may be authorized to establish the revised rates on August 1, 1970. Said petition states that both shippers and carriers desire that revisions in vehicle unit rates shall become effective on the first day of a calendar month, and that carriers are in urgent need of the additional revenues accruing from the increased vehicle unit rates.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph 3 of Decision No. 77443 is amended to read as follows:

"3. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the eighth day after the effective date of this order on not less than eight days' notice to the Commission and to the public and such tariff publications shall be made effective not later than September 1, 1970; and the tariff publications which are authorized but not required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the eighth day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than eight days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order."

In all other respects Decision No. 77443 shall remain in full force and effect.
