## OPINION

This is an application by Pacific Lighting Service Company seeking authority to exercise a franchise from the City of Garden Grove.

Applicant is engaged in the sale and purchase of gas in the central and southern portions of the State of California. The verified application avers that it has been delivering gas in the area here under consideration to its affiliate Southern Counties Gas Company under a 50-year franchise issued by the County of Orange. The county franchise expired in 1969 and was replaced by one which does not apply to incorporated areas. On January 20, 1970 the City Council of the City of Garden Grove enacted Ordinance No. 1096 which grants applicant a franchise to indefinitely conduct its gas business in the city. Applicant has included in the application a stipulation that it will not claim before this Commission or any court or other public body any value for the franchise in excess of its original cost which is stated to be the sum of \$247.59.

b. The franchise involved herein shall never be given any value before any court or other public authority in any proceeding of any character in excess of the cost to the grantee of the necessary publication and any other sum paid by it to the municipality therefor at the time of the acquisition thereof.

## ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience and necessity is granted to Pacific Lighting Service Company to exercise the rights and privileges conferred by the franchise issued pursuant to Ordinance No. 1096 of the City Council of the City of Garden Grove.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
