## SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

First supplemental order, Decision No. 77470, dated July 7, 1970 modified Decision No. 77124 dated April 21, 1970 in the above matter. In the modification of the fourth paragraph of Decision No. 77124 appearing on page 1 of Decision No. 77470, a sentence was inadvertently omitted. Consequently, the fourth paragraph of Decision No. 77124 is modified to read:

"Applicant shall bear entire expense of construction and installation of automatic protection, also maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines shall be by agreement between the parties. Maintenance costs of the automatic protection shall be borne by the applicant, pursuant to the provisions of Section 1202.2 of the Public Utilities Code."

In all other respects Decisions Nos. 77124 and 77470 shall remain in full force and effect.
