SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 77561, entered today in Application No. 52014 and Case No. 5432 (Petition for Modification No. 591), et al., the Commission authorized National Motor Freight Traffic Association, Inc., Agent, on behalf of various common carriers, to publish specific revisions in Supplement 7 to its National Motor Freight Classification A-11 (Governing Classification) effective September 2, 1970.

Certain items containing commodity descriptions in the Petroleum Products Group were renumbered in Supplement 7 to the Governing Classification. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 6-A contains rates for various articles described in the above group and refers to item numbers of the Governing Classification for specific descriptions of such articles. Certain of these item numbers will be renumbered effective September 2, 1970, pursuant to the aforementioned decision.¹

Petroleum Products as described in Items 155170 and 155350 of the Governing Classification are renumbered as Item 155250 in Supplement 7 to the Governing Classification.

In the circumstances, it appears and the Commission finds, that references in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 6-A to item numbers in the Governing Classification for descriptions of the commodities involved should correspond with the item numbers assigned to such commodities in the Governing Classification. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that Minimum Rate Tariff No. 6-A should be amended accordingly.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 6-A (Appendix A of Decision No. 67154, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective September 2, 1970, Second Revised Page 8 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and shall be made effective September 2, 1970, on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the amendments authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the amendments published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

4. In all other respects Decision No. 67154, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
