O P I N I O N

By Decision No. 74666, dated September 11, 1968, in Application No. 50426, Bekins Warehousing Corp. was authorized to suspend operations as a public utility warehouseman at Compton for a period of two years. Applicant requests that the suspension be extended for an additional two years.

It is alleged that applicant has available space in four of its warehouses within 10 miles of Compton; that no commercial storage warehouse customer has been or will be inconvenienced in any manner by the further suspension and that there has been no request for commercial warehousing at the Compton warehouse since July 1, 1966.

After consideration the Commission finds that the requested authority would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity issued to Bekins Warehousing Corp. by Decision No. 51581, dated

June 9, 1955, in Application No. 36929 and as suspended by Decision No. 74666, dated September 11, 1968, in Application No. 50426, is hereby further suspended until October 31, 1972.

2. Within sixty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public applicant shall amend its tariffs presently on file with this Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
