SUPPLEMENTARY ORDER

It appearing that Edgar L. Kelley, Sr., the respondent herein, has shown adequate hardship to justify his failure to pay the fine of \$1,717.21 required by Decision No. 74955, dated November 19, 1968, and supplements thereto, and it further appearing that respondent now shows adequate need for operating authority from this Commission and that Decisions Nos. 74955 and 76426 be amended as follows:

IT IS ORDERED that respondent is authorized to have issued to him a seasonal highway contract carrier permit to transport agricultural commodities. Such permit, however, is hereby made conditional upon a partial payment on said \$1,717.21 fine of \$100 upon the initial issuance of such permit, a second payment of \$100 upon the first renewal of such permit, and a \$50 monthly payment thereafter, until said fine of \$1,717.21 is paid in full.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
