ORDER OF DISMISSAL AS TO CERTAIN DEFENDANTS  
PURSUANT TO STIPULATION

A prehearing conference in the above matter was held in  
Los Angeles before Examiner Rogers on July 24, 1970, and continued  
to Friday, October 2, 1970. All parties were represented by legal

counsel. The parties stipulated that A. S. Vinnell, also known as Allan S. Vinnell, is deceased, and that in Case No. 8927, H. J. Yount and the Estate of A. S. Vinnell, also known as Allan S. Vinnell, should be dismissed as cross-defendants to the cross-complaint of California Cities Water Company; and that the cross-complaint of H. J. Yount and the Executors of the Estate of A. S. Vinnell, also known as Allan S. Vinnell, against Vinell-Pauley, a joint venture, composed of Pauley Petroleum, Inc., a Delaware corporation and Vinnell Constructors, a California corporation, should be dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that H. J. Yount and the Estate of A. S. Vinnell, also known as Allan S. Vinnell, are dismissed as defendants in the cross-complaint of California Cities Water Company in Case No. 8927 filed on August 1, 1969 and that the cross-complaint of H. J. Yount and Claire W. Dunton, Ernest R. Baldwin, William B. Glassick, W. B. Thompson and Robert L. Bridges as Executors of the Estate of A. S. Vinnell, also known as Allan S. Vinnell, against Vinnell-Pauley, a joint venture composed of Pauley Petroleum, Inc., a Delaware corporation, and Vinnell Constructors, a California corporation, in Case No. 8927 is dismissed.
