ORDER EXTENDING TIME

California Independent Telephone Association by letter dated July 31, 1970, has petitioned for an extension of time of about 90 days to comply with the filing of a new "Limitation of Liability" rule pursuant to Decision No. 77406.

In its petition the association affirms (1) that it prepares and files tariffs for nineteen of the respondents in the subject proceeding, (2) compliance with the decision requires preparation of 1,345 tariff sheets by a limited staff and (3) a timely preparation and filing of the required material is not possible.

Good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph No. 1 of Decision No. 77406 is changed to read:

- "1. Each respondent shall file with this Commission, on not less than five days' notice, to be effective on or before November 23, 1970, an adoption as part of its tariffs the rules set forth in Appendix A attached hereto and cancel any tariff provisions inconsistent therewith."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said Decision No. 77406 shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this order.
