ORDER EXTENDING PERIOD OF SUSPENSION

By an order of suspension and investigation, issued April 21, 1970, certain tariff sheets of Hornitos Telephone Company filed under Advice Letter No. 20, and certain tariff sheets of The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company filed under Advice Letter No. 10178 were suspended to and including August 29, 1970 and September 11, 1970, respectively, pending public hearing and further order of the Commission. It appears that conclusion of the matter may not be accomplished by August 29, 1970.

Good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS ORDERED that the operation and effectiveness of Hornitos Telephone Company Advice Letter No. 20 and The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company Advice Letter No. 10178 are hereby suspended, as provided by statute, for an additional period to and including February 28, 1971, unless otherwise hereafter ordered.

The Secretary of the Commission is directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon the Hornitos Telephone Company, and The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company and to send a copy to the Continental Telephone Company of California.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
