SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Carden City Transportation Co., Ltd, a corporation, is a highway common carrier operating under a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission. William E. Glennon, attorney for Garden City Transportation Co., Ltd, has submitted to this Commission certified copies of a Certificate of Amendment of Articles of Incorporation filed with the Secretary of State changing its corporate name to "G.C.T., Inc." Accordingly the certificate will be amended to show the new corporate name. The carrier will also be ordered to amend its tariffs pursuant to General Order No. 80A. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Decision No. 46783 dated February 19, 1952 in Application No. 32329 as amended by Decision 46815 dated March 4, 1952 and Decision No. 53157 dated May 28, 1956 is hereby further amended by substituting "G.C.T., Inc." in place and stead of "Garden City Transportation Co., Ltd."

2. Within one hundred and twenty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than thirty days notice to the Commission and the public, G.C.T., Inc. shall amend its tariffs on file with this Commission as required by Rule 6.4 of General Order No. 80A.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
