ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Complainant sought suspension of proposed tariff schedules for "Wide Spectrum Services", submitted by California Water and Telephone Company (General Telephone Company of California, successor) by Advice Letter No. 486, dated April 24, 1967. The proposed tariffs have been periodically suspended by orders issued in Case No. 8635, an investigation and suspension proceeding (Public Utilities Code, sec. 455).

General Telephone Company of California, by letter dated August 14, 1970, has notified the Commission of its withdrawal of Advice Letter No. 2245, the most recent substitute for the original Advice Letter No. 486. The Commission, by an order issued this day in Case No. 8635, has nullified the rates, rules and special conditions of the proposed tariffs filed under Advice Letter No. 2245, and has dismissed Case No. 8635. The complaint herein is thus moot.

Therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above-entitled and numbered complaint is dismissed.
