O R D E R

City of Downey is hereby authorized to construct Stewart and Gray Road at grade across the Santa Ana Branch of the Southern Pacific Transportation Company in the City of Downey, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, as amended, to be identified as Crossing No. BK-496.5.

Width of crossing shall be not less than 64 feet and grades of approach not greater than three percent as shown on plans attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 (General Order No. 72). Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) with additional flashing light signals on cantilever arms and supplemented by automatic crossing gates.

Construction expense of the crossing as well as all other costs in connection with this project shall be borne by applicant.

Maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Southern Pacific Transportation Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines.

Installation cost of the automatic crossing protection shall be borne by the applicant. Maintenance cost of the automatic protection shall be borne by the applicant, pursuant to the provisions of Section 1202.2 of the Public Utilities Code.

The crossing shall not be opened to public use until after the protection ordered herein is installed and operative.

No obstructions shall be placed or remain near the flashing light signals which will impair the motorists' view.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
