ORDER PURSUANT TO STIPULATION

Pursuant to stipulation of the parties,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Valen Parking Management, Inc., shall forthwith cease and desist from operating passenger stages to Knott's Berry Farm over the present route that is described in these proceedings to the extent that they proceed beyond the city limit of the City of Anaheim, north on Beach Boulevard, south on Grand Avenue, and east on Crescent.

2. Valen Parking Management, Inc., shall not operate more than 2 percent of its total route mileage outside the City of Anaheim. It is understood Valen Parking Management, Inc., may continue to operate to Knott's Berry Farm if that operation can be accomplished by keeping 98 percent of the operations of Valen Parking Management, Inc., as measured by the total route mileage regularly operated, within the City of Anaheim.

3. Valen Parking Management, Inc., shall submit copies of the routes that it is regularly operating to the Public Utilities Commission staff and to counsel for the complainant.

4. Case No. 9086 is dismissed without prejudice.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
