Application of THE PACIFIC TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY for authority to establish the Sly Park Special Rate Area in the Placerville Exchange

## OPINION AND ORDER

The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company (Applicant) has requested, pursuant to Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code of the State of California, authority to establish the Sly Park Special Rate Area in the Placerville Exchange.

Applicant proposes to establish rates without mileage charges for urban grades of telephone service, and to withdraw the suburban service now offered and furnished within the proposed special rate area. A summary of present and proposed special rate area rates follows:

A-52181 The Sly Park Special Rate Area as described in Exhibit B attached to the application covers approximately eight tenths of a square mile in area. It is located approximately eight miles east of the Placerville base rate area and about two miles south of the Camino-Pollock Pines Special Rate Area and will be served from the Niagara Central Office. Present telephone services within the proposed special rate area are five 1-party business, ten 1-party residence, six 2-party residence, five 4-party residence and 15 suburban residence. Development within the proposed special rate area consists of eight business enterprises and approximately 100 single-family residences. Sly Park, located in the El Dorado National Forest, is a prime Sierra recreational spot bordering Jenkinson Lake which offers a wide variety of water sports; the area includes a boat ramp, campgrounds, picnic areas and snack bars. Six subdivisions are presently under development in the vicinity. Customers in the area have requested service improvement. Applicant estimates that the establishment of the Sly Park special rate area will decrease applicant's annual revenues by approximately \$1,200. Applicant proposes rates for primary urban grades of service within the Sly Park special rate area equivalent to Placerville base rates plus an increment equal to three one-quarter mile suburban mileage charges. This increment gives appropriate consideration to development within the proposed special rate area, its distance from the base rate area and the effect or establishing the proposed special rate area upon applicant's revenues. Applicant also proposes to furnish Placerville urban service outside the special rate areas or the base rate area at -2-

- 3. Applicant is authorized to withdraw suburban telephone service within the Sly Park special rate area coincident with establishment of said special rate area.
- 4. After the effective date of this order, applicant is authorized to file with this Commission in conformity with General Order No. 96-A exchange maps revised to show the Sly Park special rate area within the Placerville Exchange with a boundary substantially as shown in Exhibits A and B attached to this application.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
