SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Directory 1 sets forth descriptions of production areas, delivery zones and rules, which govern the minimum zone rates named in Minimum Rate Tariff 17 for the transportation of certain property in dump truck equipment by highway carriers within defined areas in Southern California.

It has come to the Commission's attention that the description of Los Angeles County Delivery Zone 19286 contained on Original Page 67 of Directory 1 does not include all of the land area shown within that zone on Page 89 of map Exhibit A-18 in Order Setting Hearing dated March 24, 1959, Case 5437.

It appears, and the Commission finds, that the description of Delivery Zone 19286 in Directory 1 should be enlarged to encompass all of the land area involved. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that Directory 1 should be amended accordingly.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Directory 1 (Appendix A of Decision No. 69469, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein to become effective November 28, 1970, First Revised Page 67 and First Revised Page 68, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. In all other respects, Decision No. 69469, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective 24 days after the date hereof.
