OPINION AND ORDER

Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 contains less-truckload exception ratings for the transportation of furniture and related articles. which apply in lieu of those named in National Motor Freight Classification A-11 (Governing Classification). These ratings are scheduled to expire with December 31, 1970, and higher class ratings in the Governing Classification would apply to this transportation should the ratings in question be allowed to expire. By this petition, Furniture Manufacturers Association of California requests that the expiration date be extended to December 31, 1971.

Petitioner states that the Commission established the exception ratings on furniture and related articles for the purpose of effecting an orderly transition to the Governing Classification. Petitioner alleges that the Interstate Commerce Commission is currently conducting an investigation (I.C.C. Docket No. 34922 - Classification Ratings on Furniture) into the reasonableness of the increased furniture ratings in the Governing Classification and that a Recommended Report and Order has been issued which would order such proposed increases cancelled on interstate traffic. Petitioner

declares that exceptions to such Recommended Report and Order have been filed by respondents in said proceeding and there are strong indications that, regardless of final action of the Interstate Commerce Commission, all regulatory and judicial appeal procedures will be exhausted before the matter is finally concluded.

Petitioner avers that the Commission has stated in prior proceedings that uniformity of classification provisions applicable in California with those applicable elsewhere is desirable and asserts that the proposed extension of the expiration date governing the aforementioned exception ratings is sought to allow adequate time for related interstate matters to be resolved.

A copy of the verified petition was mailed to the California Trucking Association and William Volker & Company on or about July 2, 1970. The petition was also listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of July 7, 1970. No objection to the granting of the petition has been received.

Commission staff analysis discloses that the proposed extension of the expiration date governing the involved exception ratings would retain the current lower ratings and relationships with interstate rates on furniture and related articles for an additional year. The staff recommends that the petition be granted by ex parte order.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the proposed extension of the exception ratings on furniture and related articles is reasonable. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the petition should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 (Appendix A to Decision No. 66195, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein to become effective January 1, 1971, Fourth Revised Page 27-A, Sixth Revised Page 27-B and Third Revised Page 27-C attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 2. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject also to Decision No. 66195, as amended, are hereby directed to establish in their tariffs the amendments necessary to conform with the further adjustments ordered herein.
- 3. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and shall be made effective January 1, 1971, on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public and tariff publications which are authorized but not required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than January 1, 1971, and may be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than March 2, 1971.
- 4. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the amendments authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding

authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the amendments published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

5. In all other respects Decision No. 66195, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty-four days after the date hereof.
